This house, the Kellogg House, at 232 South Main Street, was used to hide runaway slaves before the Civil War. The house is the oldest home in Sycamore today. There was one other home east of town, on Old State Road, where runaway slaves could hide. Usually, after having stayed in Sycamore, the runaway slaves would travel to St. Charles.
