

# One Minute in Sycamore History



Where have you seen this statue before? What is this statue symbolic of?

Soldiers Monuments is on the lawn of the Dekalb County Courthouse.

The Dekalb County Soldiers Monument was dedicated in 1897. This statue stands over fifty feet high. On the Top of the statue is the granite figure of an American Civil War Color - bearer. In his right hand he holds the handle of his sword and in his left hand is a flag. On the memorial's base are two statues representing the cavalry, and infantry arms of the service. This structure is a memorial to the thousands of Dekalb County residents who served in the American Civil War.
